Three days of float flying at beautiful Greenfield State Park and the beach on Otter Lake. Bring the family, camp, relax, and enjoy all that this park and the Monadnock Region have to offer. We promise a good time for everyone!

- **25 campsites with easy access to the beach area are available for participants.**
- **The park has a total of 241 campsites including designated pet areas.**
- **Beautiful wide-open beach for fly-in event.**
- **Secure, overnight charging for your planes (free).**
- **Flying starts Friday after setup is complete. Saturday and Sunday flying starts at 7am for Electric entries and 9:00am to 5:30pm for all others.**
- **AMA sanctioned, all rules and regulations apply.**
- **Plaque Awards for Best Scale, Best Sport, Most Unusual, and CD's Choice.**

Event Details: This is an AMA sanctioned fly-in, all AMA rules apply. Each aircraft will be subject to a safety inspection before flying and after any crash repairs. All pilots must be accompanied by a spotter for each flight, no exceptions! Friday afternoon is open flying after the site is set up. Flying begins Saturday and Sunday at 7:00am for electric entries, 9:00am for all others and ends at 5:30pm. A 12:30 to 1pm break will occur each day when non-flying vehicles may be operated.

Fees: The participant event fee is \$12 for the weekend, plus your admission to the park. Greenfield State Park <http://www.nhstateparks.com/greenfield.html> has set aside 25 special sites for our participants wanting to camp. These sites are conveniently located close to the event beach and have bathhouse, dump station and potable water nearby. The park ranger collects your campsite fee when you check in. Call 603-318-3774 or email president@snhflyingeagles.org to reserve one of these sites. If you don't camp, the park ranger at the entrance gate collects a \$2.50 day use fee. As a courtesy to the participants, the camp store will be used to house and charge our planes overnight. Bring an extra power strip to share if you have them.

NOTE: New Hampshire State Law prohibits pets on public beaches. Please do not bring your dogs to the flying event. Thanks!
